- ▶ Once all the artwork is tagged and scanned and put in the appropriate folder it's time to archive them



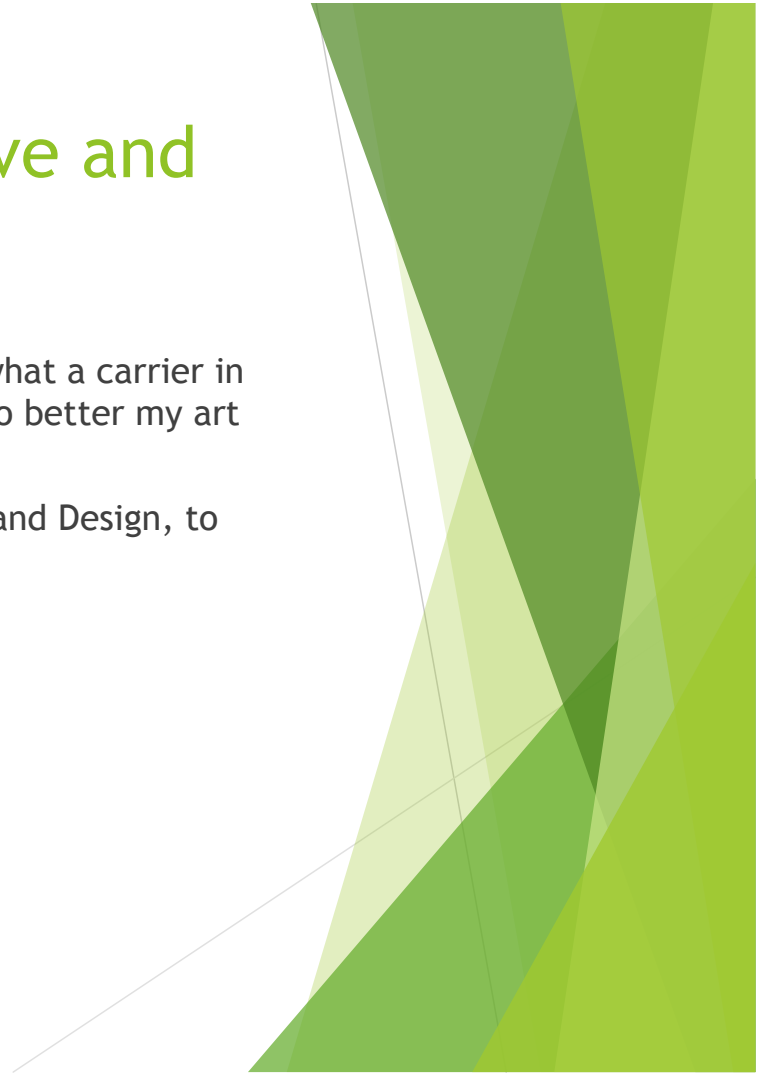
# Drawing at Springs Creative
