Focus of Discussion:

The top priority in all decisions made by Rock Hill Schools is the health, safety, and well-being of our students, employees and school communities. Decisions were based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC).

A brief discussion about Summer Program/Transition Summer Camps to bridge the gap between kids who have been out for a while and maybe behind to attend this program. Will communicate more details once available.

Cultivating Emotional Resilience in areas of Mental Health and Social-Emotional Learning for Students, Staff and Community - Ms. Ratliff added that there would be more programs to be implemented to

address issues of mental health as well as maintaining the well-being of students in school (for more information, see page 7 – 9 of the draft)

Question: Mrs. Scott asked if the school has capacity issues since social distancing will be imposed. Mr. Sawyer had a discussion with Mr. Ahl about the number of students coming in person, and that social distancing will be addressed during the board meeting tonight. Information about this issue will be communicated once available.

SIC Future Plans and Events: To communicate before the August 5th Freshmen Orientation to discuss plans to set up an SIC table to promote and invite new members. It was suggested to exchange phone numbers to keep an open line of communication moving forward.

Questions for Mr. Ahl

1. What is the expected enrollment for RHHS next year?

Currently we have 1975 students enrolled for the 2021-2022 school year. About 170 are full virtual so we should have about 1800 students on campus

2. With these numbers will we be able to continue to social distance (3 feet)?

With 1800 students on campus we will not be able to socially distance in all classrooms. We will in rooms where enrollment allows.

3. What are the dates for the transition summer camp?

The summer programs we are working on will occur the week of August 2 – August 5.

4. Will the SIC be allowed to have a table at August orientation days?

The SIC is always welcome to set up a table at our Orientations and Open House.
